• VOLUNTARY

- *AGREE TO PARTICIPATE
- *RIGHT TO WITHDRAW
- *ALL DECISIONS MADE FREELY

• INFORMED CONSENT

- * ABOUT THE PROCESS
- *ABOUT RIGHTS, OPTIONS, RESOURCES
- *CAPABLE TO PARTICIPATE

• CONFIDENTIAL

- *MEDIATORS WON'T DISCUSS OUT OF SESSION *MEDIATORS WON'T REPEAT PRIVATE INFO IF ASKED NOT TO
- NEUTRAL

*MEDIATORS WON'T SHOW BIAS IN WORD OR DEED

• SELF-DETERMINATION

*PARTIES HAVE THE RIGHT AND ABILITY TO SOLVE THEIR OWN DISPUTES

MEDIATION STEPS

1. INTRODUCTION

WELCOME – GIVE INFORMATION

2. FIRST JOINT SESSION (everyone together)

GET INFORMATION – WHAT HAPPENED?

MEDIATOR BREAK – MAKE A PLAN

3. FIRST PRIVATE SESSIONS (each person alone)

GET INFORMATION – WHAT'S THIS BEEN LIKE?

MEDIATOR BREAK – MAKE A PLAN

4. LATER PRIVATE SESSIONS (each person alone)

TRANSMIT INFORMATION – WHAT DO YOU WANT TO DO?

MEDIATOR BREAK – MAKE A PLAN

5. LAST JOINT SESSION (everyone together)

LOOK AT OPTIONS – DECIDE WHAT TO DO

6. WRITE AGREEMENT

WIN-WIN, BALANCED, CLEAR, SPECIFIC, WORKABLE

MEDIATION PROCESS

JOINT SESSION

• WHAT'S THIS BEEN LIKE?

FIRST PRIVATES

• WHAT DO YOU WANT TO DO?

LATER PRIVATES

• HERE'S WHAT YOU AGREE TO

LAST JOINT and AGREEMENT WRITING

- *A MEDIATOR IS EDUCATED BY THE PARTIES
- *MANAGE THE PROCESS NOT THE OUTCOME
- *ALWAYS ADHERE TO THE MEDIATION PRINCIPLES
